## POPE FRANCIS' LATEST ENCYCLICAL FRATELLI TUTTI: (ON FRATERNITY AND SOCIAL FRIENDSHIP)

*"Let us dream, then, as a single human family, as fellow travellers sharing the same flesh, as children of the same earth which is our common home, each of us bringing the richness of his or her beliefs and convictions, each of us with his or her own voice, brothers and sisters all."*

On 4 October 2020, Feast of St Francis of Assisi, Pope Francis released a new encyclical: *Fratelli Tutti: On Fraternity and Social Friendship*, which explores *building a culture of peace and dialogue in order to work together to care for each other as a human family, especially as we recover from the Coronavirus pandemic*. The Maryknoll Office for Global Concerns (\*\*see note below) has created a 6-page study guide for Fratelli Tutti, which offers key points and quotes from each chapter of Fratelli Tutti, along with reflection questions and the two prayers that Pope Francis includes at the end of the encyclical.

Fratelli Tutti is the third 'instalment' in a trilogy from Pope Francis. The first, *Evangelii Gaudium (Joy of the Gospel)* focuses on reparation of the Church. The Second, *Laudato Si' (Praised Be)* looks at reparation of the planet. *Fratelli Tutti (Brothers and Sisters All)* explores building a culture of peace and dialogue in order to work together to care for each other. "The Holy Father offers a remedy against self-destruction and despair, which includes an openness to love, charity, and kindness, and a rejection of war, nuclear weapons and the death penalty. Like *Laudato Si'*, Fratelli Tutti is a social encyclical, where the Pope applies the moral teachings of the Church to the social and economic challenges of the current day. Also, like *Laudato Si'*, this encyclical is inspired by the life of St Francis of Assisi, who responded to the Church and the world in his time, and is structured using the three-part \*See-Judge-Act method (\*A method used by the Young Christian Workers)

**Chapter 1: Dark Clouds Over a Closed World**, "A worldwide tragedy like the Covid-19 pandemic momentarily revived the sense that we are a global community, all in the same boat, where one person's problems are the problems of all.

**Chapter 2: A Stranger on the Road** "Each day we have to decide whether to be Good Samaritans or indifferent bystanders

**Chapter 3: Envisaging and Engendering an Open World** "All of us, as believers, need to recognize that love takes first place: love must never be put at risk, and the greatest danger lies in failing to love (92)."

**Chapter 4** A Heart Open to the Whole World. **Chapter 5. A Better Kind of Politics. Chapter 6 Dialogue and Friendship in Society. Chapter 7 Paths of Renewed Encounter. Chapter 8. Religions at the Service of Fraternity in our World**

\*\*Maryknoll is a name shared by three organizations - a society of apostolic life, a religious institute and a lay ministry - that are part of the Roman Catholic Church. They began in 1911 and work closely together focussing on overseas mission activity, moving into rough areas and living side-by-side with the indigenous peoples.

Grant that we Christians may live the Gospel, discovering Christ in each human being, recognizing him crucified in the sufferings of the abandoned and forgotten of our world, and risen in each brother or sister who makes a new start. Come, Holy Spirit, show us your beauty, reflected in all the peoples of the earth, so that we may discover anew that all are important and all are necessary, different faces of the one humanity that God so loves. Amen.
