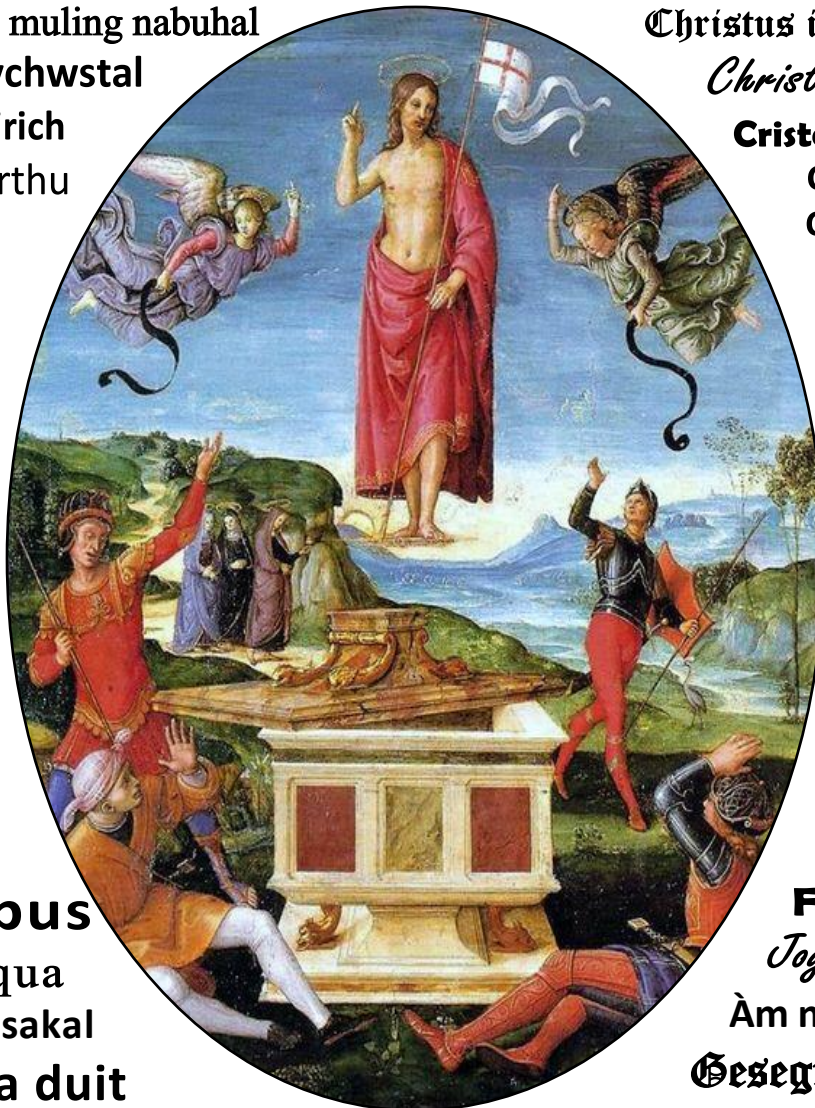

WE ARE NOW IN THE OCTAVE OF EASTER - this is 8 consecutive days beginning on Easter Sunday and ending the following Sunday (LOW SUNDAY), which is celebrated as one continuous solemnity rejoicing in the feast of Easter.

EASTER IS NOT JUST A DAY – it is a season of 50 days lasting up until Pentecost, during which we continue to celebrate.

To qualify, you need to pay sufficient tax to cover the amount of Gift Aid claimable (we can claim 25p for every £1 you donate). It is completely confidential, and we do not get to know anything about your earnings. **If you Gift Aid your offerings (by envelope or by standing order) and have changed your address or phone number in the last year, it is important to update us. If you no longer pay sufficient tax, it is also essential you let us know.**
